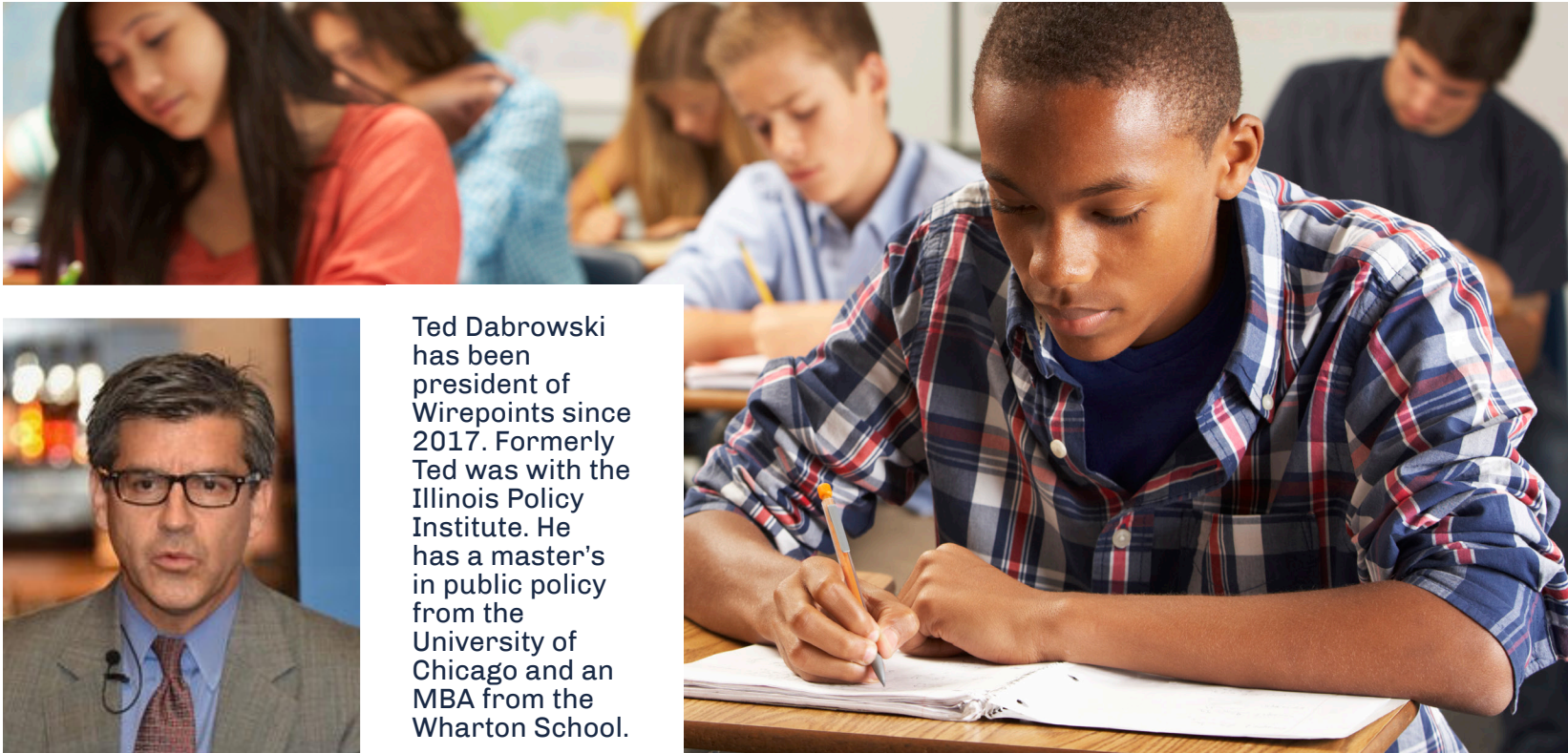


# Public Education in Rockford: SPENDING VS. OUTCOMES
